MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETINGS

The Board voted unanimously to approve minutes of the June 21, 2012 Plumbing and Piping Work Examining Board meeting.

APPLICATIONS

Anthony P. D'Apice, Jr., Bethpage, NY – (P-1) Unlimited Contractor – Approved (P-2) Mr. D'Apice, Jr., after discussion with the Board, chose to amend the category of license sought on his application from (P-1) to (P-2). The Board voted unanimously to approve Mr. D'Apice, Jr.'s application based on equivalent experience and training.

LATE ARRIVING APPLICATIONS

The Board voted unanimously to approve Mr. Erlandson's due to lack of a required (P-6) Limited Journeyman license for a minimum of two years and lack of a required (P-6) Limited Journeyman apprenticeship completion certificate. The Board is requesting that DCP Trade Enforcement open an investigation into Mr. Erlandson engaging in the plumbing trade without a plumbing license or apprenticeship registration and his employer permitting him to perform plumbing work without a license or apprenticeship registration.
